

Health and Safety Plan for Indoor Programs

It is the policy of Newtown Township Parks & Recreation to comply with all federal, state and local requirements regarding safe practices and operations to reduce the spread of Covid-19.

- Instructors and participants will be required to wear face masks and practice social distancing.
- Instructors and participants will be encouraged to wash their hands on a frequent basis. Hand sanitizer will also be available.
- Class size will be limited to allow for physical distancing.
- Participants will have their own equipment whenever possible. Shared equipment will be cleaned before use by another group.
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Windows will be opened, weather permitting, to provide ventilation.
- Parents can enter the building to drop off/pick up their child, however, parents must wait outside while the class is going on.
- Participants (or their guardians) are expected to monitor their health and to determine whether they should be attending class on any given day. This includes having been exposed to COVID-19 or feeling flu-like symptoms 14 days prior to a class; and/or having a temperature above 100 degrees (F) in the previous 48 hours prior to class.
- If a confirmed case of COVID-19 is reported, all participants will be notified. The CDC and the Bucks County Board of Health will be contacted for further guidance.
