

Drop Off Procedures

- Before arriving at camp, parents/guardians should self assess themselves and their campers for any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Drop off for all camps will be curbside, parents **must** remain in the car.
- Please make sure children exit on the passenger side if possible. Have our littlest campers practice buckling and unbuckling to ensure a swift drop off and pick up.
- If dropping off late, parents should call the Camp Director, who will meet you and your camper outside (phone numbers will be provided on the first day of camp).
- Drop off can begin 15 minutes before camp, 8:45 am for Camp Newtown, Teen Camp, Playground Camp; 9:00 am for Camp Beechtree.

Pick Up Procedures

- Pick up will be curbside, parents must remain in the car
- With the exception of Teen Camp, each family will receive four name placards for pick up which will need to be displayed on the dash (placards will be provided on the first day of camp)
- With the exception of Teen Camp, during pick up parents/guardians must have their placard. If you do not have a placard in your vehicle you will be asked for a photo ID and **MUST** be listed as an authorized pick up person. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- If picking up outside of camp ending times, parents should call the Camp Director, who will bring your camper outside (phone numbers will be provided on the first day of camp). ***Please note, you will be assessed a late charge if picking up your camper after car line (approximately 10 minutes)***

Please be aware of the safety of others when dropping off or picking up your child. Be considerate and patient, and watch your speed when pulling in and out of the parking lot. Due to COVID-19, parents are not allowed inside the school. Campers will be brought outside for pickup except for after care at Camp Newtown.

After Care at Camp Newtown

- After care parents will need to park in Newtown Elementary's back parking lot (next to the shed/playground) and walk into the cafeteria. There will be a table there, please do not go past the table – we will call your child and bring them to you. You must have your ID or car placard when picking up your camper. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
